This is to certify that the DEPA PTFE diaphragms are manufactured from materials listed in the relevant sections of the Code of Federal Regulations [Food and Drugs] with respect to rubber articles in contact with food [para. 177.1550 and 177.2600 of section 21 Code of Federal Regulations revised 1<sup>st</sup> April 1999].

The DEPA PTFE diaphragms are manufactured from virgin PTFE facing and sulphurless cured Black EPDM [Ethylene Propylene Diene], ter-Polymer support backing formulated by Saunders' own technologists, to comply with the current Food and Drug Administration Regulations.

Furthermore, the DEPA PTFE/EPDM diaphragms have undergone intensive product testing for aqueous and fatty food contact, confirming the suitability of the PTFE compound, with regard to extractables, as laid down in the American Food and Drug Administration Regulations, [para.177.2600 (e)].
